**SCOLA EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION TO BROADCAST**  
**FRENCH MUSIC VIDEOS IN NORTH AMERICA**

OMAHA, NEBRASKA --- SCOLA Educational Television announces the broadcasting of authentic French language music videos on The SCOLA Channel this fall.

The music videos, intended for use by language educators and students, will highlight the songs and music of Carole Fredericks of the French rock group Fredericks Goldman Jones. Fredericks is an African-American singer who emigrated to France in 1979. Although French was not her native tongue, Fredericks mastered the language and became a renowned recording artist in the French-speaking world.

The French language music videos will be broadcast on The SCOLA Channel on Wednesdays at 4:00 Eastern / 3:00 pm Central beginning September 22. For the convenience of French language teachers and students, the program is re-run on Saturdays at 7:30 pm Eastern / 6:30 pm Central.
